

Summary on Swab Test Registration/Exemption Procedures for the Marine & Process Sectors [Updated on 18 January 2021]

7 Day Rostered Routine Testing [Updated 18 Jan 2021]

From 9 January 2020, as part of enhanced precautionary measures, <u>all workers supporting the Marine Sector</u> are required to undergo Rostered Routine Testing on every 7 Day intervals until further notice.

Marine Sector Workers 7d RRT Requirements [With Effect from 09 Jan 2021]

Employers are required to ensure workers attend Rostered Routine Test (RRT) to resume work, unless they have been registered for exemption from RRT. The RRT will be carried out by the Health Promotion Board. Workers who missed their RRT cycle will have their AccessCode status turned red and cannot be deployed to work. You may refer to the Sector-specific Safe Management Requirements, Marine & Offshore FAQ, and Process Construction & Maintenance (PCM) Sector FAQ for more information.
